ROMANS 14:19 - So then let us pursue the things which make for peace and the building up of one another.

1 PETER 1:22 - Since you have in obedience to the truth purified your souls for a sincere love of the brethren, fervently love one another from the heart,

EPHESIANS 4:29 - Let no unwholesome word proceed from your mouth, but only such a word as is good for edification according to the need of the moment, that it may give grace to those who hear.

HEBREWS 13:17 - Obey your leaders, and submit to them; for they keep watch over your souls, as those who will give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with grief, for this would be unprofitable for you.

2. To share in the responsibility of Life Change Tullahoma.

- a. By praying for its people, leaders, and mission.
- b. By inviting others to attend.
- c. By warmly welcoming those who visit.

1 THESSALONIANS 1:2 - We give thanks to God always for all of you, making mention of you in our prayers;

LUKE 14:23 - "And the master said to the slave, 'Go out into the highways and along the hedges, and compel them to come in, that my house may be filled.

ROMANS 15:7 - Wherefore, accept one another, just as Christ also accepted us to the glory of God.

3. To serve the ministry of Life Change Tullahoma.

- a. By seeking to discover my gifts and talents.
- b. By using my gifts and talents to serve others
- c. By developing a servant's heart.
- d. By sharing the hope of Christ with others.

ROMANS 12:6-8 - We have different gifts, according to the grace given us. If a man's gift is prophesying, let him use it in proportion to his faith. ⁷If it is serving, let him serve; if it is teaching, let him teach; ⁸if it is encouraging, let him encourage; if it is contributing to the needs of others, let him give generously; if it is leadership, let him govern diligently; if it is showing mercy, let him do it cheerfully.

1PETER 4:10 - As each one has received a special gift, employ it in serving one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God.

PHILIPPIANS 2:3-4 - Do nothing from selfishness or empty conceit, but with humility of mind let each of you regard one another as more important than himself; do not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.

1 PETER 3:15 - But in your hearts set apart Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have.

4. To support the testimony of Life Change Tullahoma.

- a. By attending faithfully.
- b. By living a life that honors Christ.
- c. By giving cheerfully.

ACTS 2:42-47 - They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. ⁴³Everyone was filled with awe, and many wonders and miraculous signs were done by the apostles. ⁴⁴All the believers were together and had everything in common. ⁴⁵Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need. ⁴⁶Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, ⁴⁷praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

HEBREWS 10:24-25 - And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. ²⁵Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.

PHILIPPIANS 1:27 - Only conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ; so that whether I come and see you or remain absent, I may hear of you that you are standing firm in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel;

2 CORINTHIANS 9:6-7 - Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. ⁷Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.
